  - a. Objectivity (50%)
    - o Events (25%)
    - o Finance and Publicity (25%)
  - b. Supplementary materials (50%)
    - o Activities (20%)
    - o Circle K examples (10%)
    - o Kiwanis examples (10%)
    - o Information not previously included (10%)

All parts shall be bound together in some suitable manner (i.e., stapled, bound in notebook or other binder, etc.).

4. This entry form must be signed by the individuals as indicated and submitted with your club's essay **before the end of Registration on the Friday night of Convention.**
5. First, Second, and Third place awards will be presented only if suitable applications are received. Failure to comply to with award criteria will result in disqualification. All decisions of the judges are final.

Should not exceed two pages double-spaced in length.
  
3. The award nomination should be presented in paragraph form under the following headings:
  - o Attendance at Circle K meetings/events (25%)
  - o Support for and communication with Circle K clubs (25%)
  - o Promotion of Circle K clubs (25%)
  - o Kiwanis Family experience (25%)
  
4. This entry form, signed by the club officers as factually correct, shall be submitted with your essay **before the end of Registration on the Friday night of Convention.**
  
5. The New England District Board will judge the Chester Bogushas Award. Only one award will be given each year. If no suitable candidate is submitted, then no award will be presented. Failure to comply to with award criteria will result in disqualification. All decisions of the judges are final.
